Founder’s Letter

It has been almost twenty years since Annika’s passing. It seems like a lifetime ago. I was 36, still in the throes of creating my first successful business. We were living in Nonthaburi, Thailand, in an old wooden house next to the Chao Phraya River. Annika was running a mystery shopping business called Hotel IQ. Malta, Iniala, children, were not even on the horizon. Then, an irrational act of hatred ended Annika’s life and changed the course of mine forever.

Unexpected things often change our lives. During that period of my life, I felt as though I was living in a movie. Being in New York on September 11, escaping the Boxing Day tsunami by climbing onto the roof of my home, and losing my fiancée, Annika, in the Bali Bombings.

These events made me re-evaluate who I was and what my purpose here on earth was. They were the impetus to what is now Inspirasia Foundation. However, the foundation we are today has been created by the hard work and dedication of many individuals. Inspirasia Foundation’s Management and Board, as well as the team at the Annika Linden Centre in Bali, have been responsible for ensuring that we create sustainable positive change in thousands of people’s lives through the continuous support we have given to various organisations in Indonesia, Thailand, India and Malta.

This book is a celebration of our journey and our achievements. However, it is much more than that. We hope it will also act as an inspiration to others. When we renamed to Inspirasia Foundation, it was with the aim of adopting a new mission, a mission to inspire. The inspirational work of our foundation has only just begun.

This year, we are excited to be transforming the Malta Social Impact Awards, which fund great social impact initiatives, into a televised format which will enable us to encourage more people to get involved in positive social change. In addition, we are launching a Corporate Social Responsibility and Philanthropy Consultancy and the Academy of Givers, which will encourage companies and individuals to give better, share best practices and inspire one another.

The Covid-19 disaster affected the whole world. How you react to these momentous changes will define you as a person. Hopefully, the pandemic will teach us all that we need to change our ways. We all need to reach out and work together for the common good. I hope that this book serves as an inspiration to you. We can’t all be blessed with good health and prosperity, but we can all do something to help others.

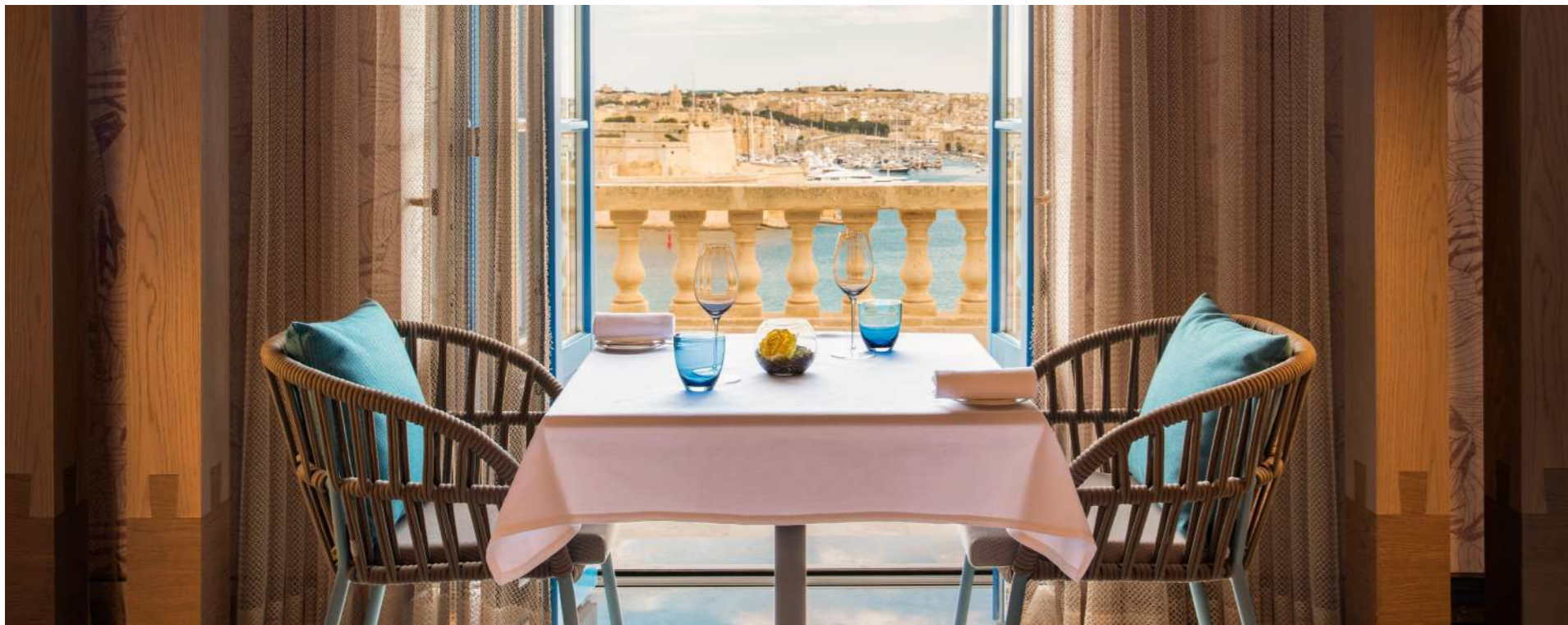

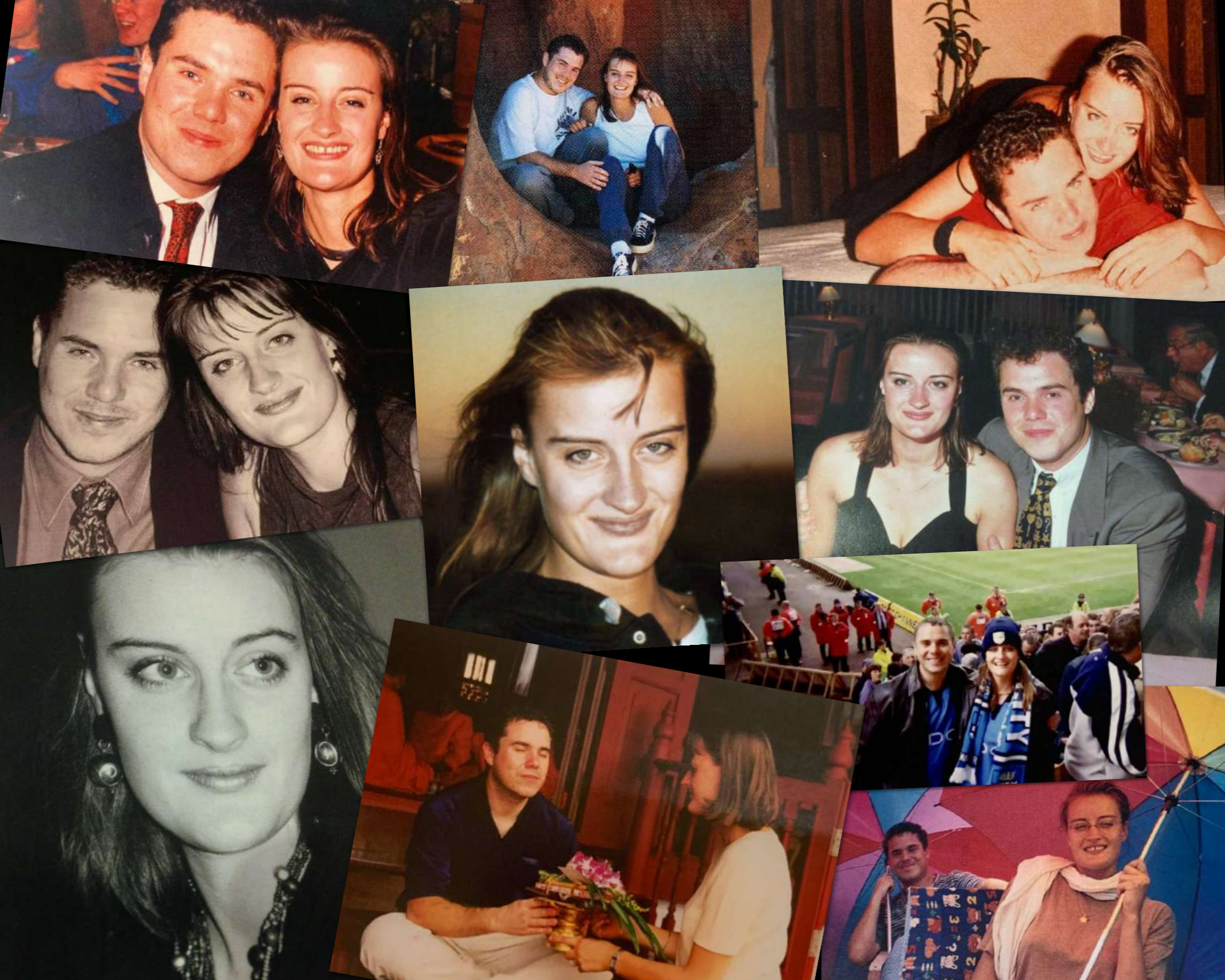

In 2002, 202 people were killed in a terrorist attack in Bali, Indonesia. Among them was Mark Weingard's fiancée, Annika Linden. Devastated by his loss, Mark was inspired to help those affected by the bombings. And so, the Annika Linden Foundation was set up in 2003 as a vehicle for Mark's personal giving.

In 2009, the name changed to Inspirasia Foundation and took on another mission - that of "inspiring others to give and give well". Since then, Inspirasia has grown into a leading grant-making foundation that works together with partners to make an impact.

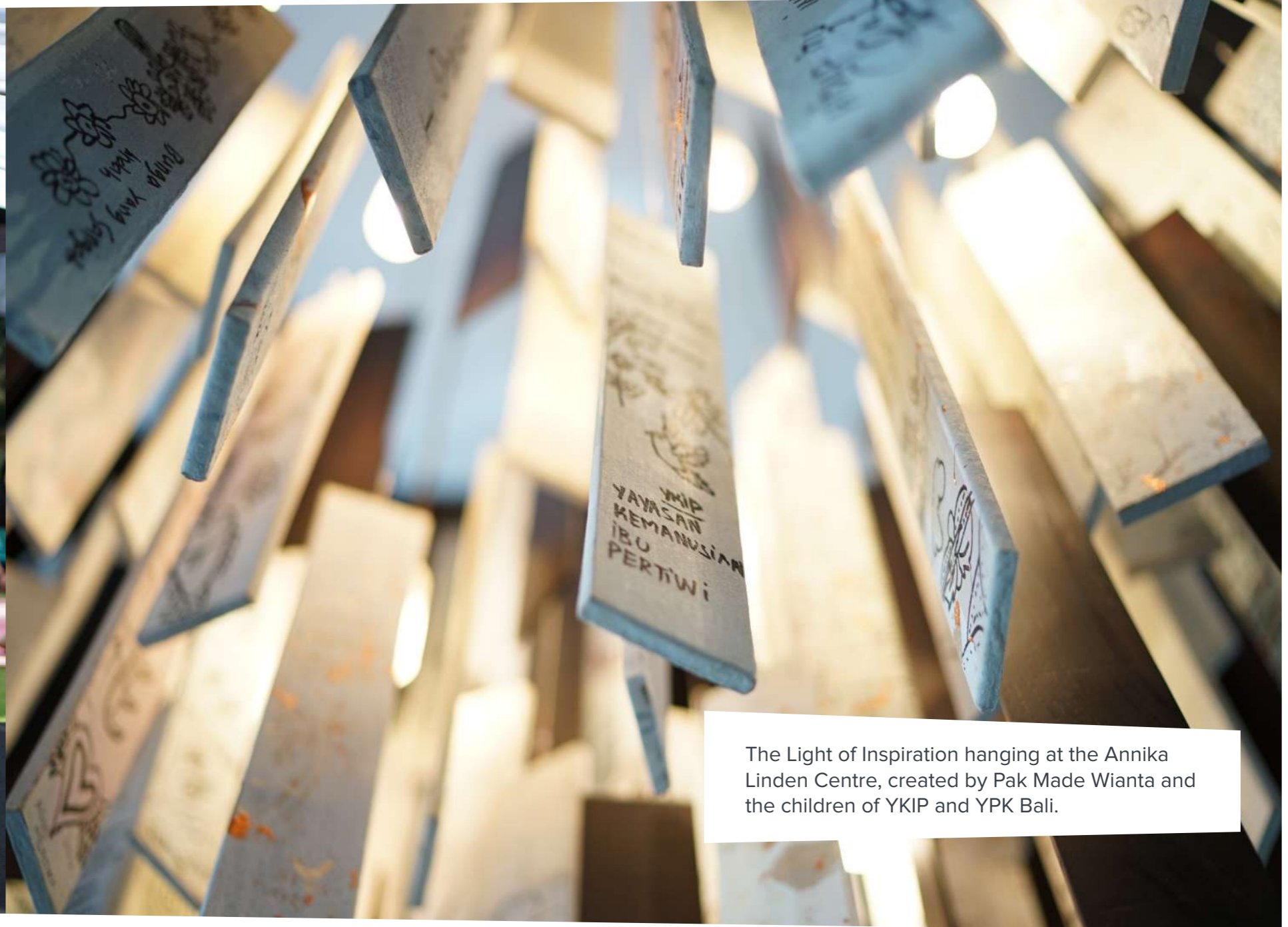

YPK Bali was founded in 2001 as a response to the urgent need for therapy for persons with disabilities from poor backgrounds. By providing affordable, caring and professional education and health services, YPK aims to improve the independence and quality of life of people with disabilities and support them so

that they can reach their full potential. YPK runs four programmes: Rehabilitation, Education, BaliRungu Hearing and a Mobile Clinic. Inspirasia Foundation has been supporting YPK Bali since 2010 and has been part of YPK's journey, to grow and become one of Bali's leading organisations.

What if every kid can?

“ I am so proud to see the positive changes in my son. Before, I felt ashamed to take him out and wondered why this had happened to my son and my family. It was such an extra burden for me. But now, after attending YPK's programme, I can get all the answers and solutions I need to support my son by helping him with therapy and the chance to practice and learn. He now smiles a lot and loves to sing. I no longer feel self-conscious when I go out with him. And I know that I'm not alone in this fight. ”

PUSPADI Bali has restored dignity and hope in the lives of thousands of people with disabilities across Bali and East Indonesia, through the provision of quality prosthetics, orthotics, and wheelchairs. Through its four core programmes of Rehabilitation, Skills Training, Education, and Advocacy, PUSPADI Bali is helping people with disabilities from impoverished areas have a better future and be able to dream big.

People with disabilities that have been supported by PUSPADI Bali have gone on to reach their goals and aspirations such as furthering their education, or becoming elite athletes and dancers, while others have started their own business and become entrepreneurs, among others. Inspirasia Foundation has been a core supporter of PUSPADI Bali since 2004.

What if persons with disabilities had access to mobility?

“ Because of Puspadi’s assistance and support, I could continue my education up to university level and participate in all activities without feeling that there are obstacles. I am also able to pursue my hobby, dancing, because of the prosthetic limbs that I have. If Puspadi Bali and Inspirasia Foundation hadn’t helped me, I would not have been able to know what the outside world looks like, and maybe until today, I would have just stayed at home without attending any education. 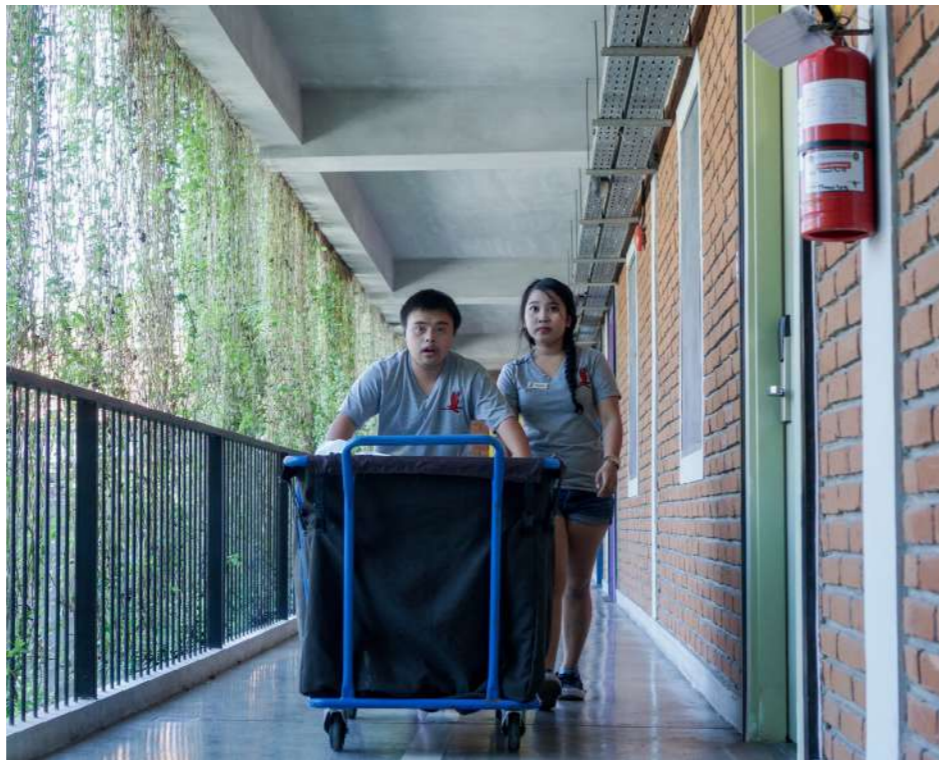

Yayasan Kemanusiaan Ibu Pertiwi (YKIP)

Improving the lives of poor families in Bali by breaking the cycle of poverty through educational support and services.

Established only days after the Bali Bombing in October 2002, YKIP aims to improve the lives of marginalised communities in Bali through educational opportunities by providing scholarships to children from disadvantaged families, children who have been affected by disaster, children with physical disabilities or

orphans. Over the years, YKIP has supported hundreds of children in Bali, with the majority of these children completing their studies and finding successful employment. Inspirasia Foundation is proud to be a core supporter of YKIP’s Kembali, Vocational and University Programmes since 2003.

What if education could change the lives of a whole family?

“ I never imagined that I would get a scholarship. I started to receive the scholarship after I finished elementary school. My mother was a housewife who never had a fixed income and my father passed away when I was eight months old. I am grateful that I was given the opportunity to continue my education, which included a year of training in the hotel and hospitality field. The support that was given to me has allowed me to get a decent job and support my family. ”

East Bali Poverty Project (EBPP)

Helping the thousands of people living in abject poverty in East Bali.

Prioritising the health, nutrition and education of children, the East Bali Poverty Project is a comprehensive rural development project that aims to eliminate poverty and promote culturally sensitive, sustainable social and economic development in the impoverished rural communities of East Bali, Indonesia. Since its foundation, EBPP has served over 12,000 families within East Bali communities,

providing quality education leading to more students graduating, and improving infrastructure and health. Inspirasia Foundation supported East Bali Poverty Project from 2004, funding their senior and high schools in Manikaji, as well as their Comprehensive Health Programme and their Dental Health Programme.

What if remote villages had access to a better life?

Malta Social Impact Fair

An ecosystem of inspiration.

From deep-rooted voluntary organisations that continuously endeavour to make a difference in the lives of others, to the ambitious social entrepreneurs that have devised innovative solutions to the country's pressing issues – Malta's community of passionate changemakers is thriving, and continues to make a positive impact on Malta and its people. With over 40 dedicated stands, The Malta Social Impact Fair, which was held in November 2019, hosted a handpicked selection of both well-established and up-and-coming local foundations, NGOs and social initiatives. These inspiring initiatives all address pressing social issues relating to the environment, education, physical and mental health, poverty and inequality, as well as others. The Fair allowed the general public, including businesses and philanthropists, to learn about the various initiatives in the sector and discover how they can be part of the positive impact.



Malta Social Impact Awards (MSIA)

Creating opportunities for changemakers and inspiring others to give and give well.

In 2016, Inspirasia Foundation launched the Malta Social Impact Awards, an initiative that provides opportunities for local changemakers to receive financial and non-financial support to develop initiatives that have a positive social impact on Malta. With the support of businesses and philanthropists, The Malta Social Impact Awards has given over €410,000 to help social purpose

organisations grow into stronger entities. Over the years, the MSIA winning initiatives have had an impact on the lives of thousands of individuals in Malta, from children to the elderly, migrants and disadvantaged groups, as well as people suffering from mental or physical health issues. Malta Social Impact Awards 5th Edition

Broadcasted on national television to allow all Malta to be part of the impact.

In 2021, the Malta Social Impact Awards (MSIA) took to the screens for the first time ever, airing the MSIA 5th Edition on Maltese national television as an exciting competition-based reality show that gave all of Malta the chance to be part of the impact from the comfort of their home. The five MSIA finalists pitched their inspiring initiatives to the panel of judges during the

programme, which was aired on the 27th March. While the 1st place winners were chosen by the judges, the 2nd and 3rd place winners were chosen by the public via SMS voting. Over 20,000 people viewed the programme and a total of €94,000, together with additional non-financial support, was awarded to the three winning initiatives.

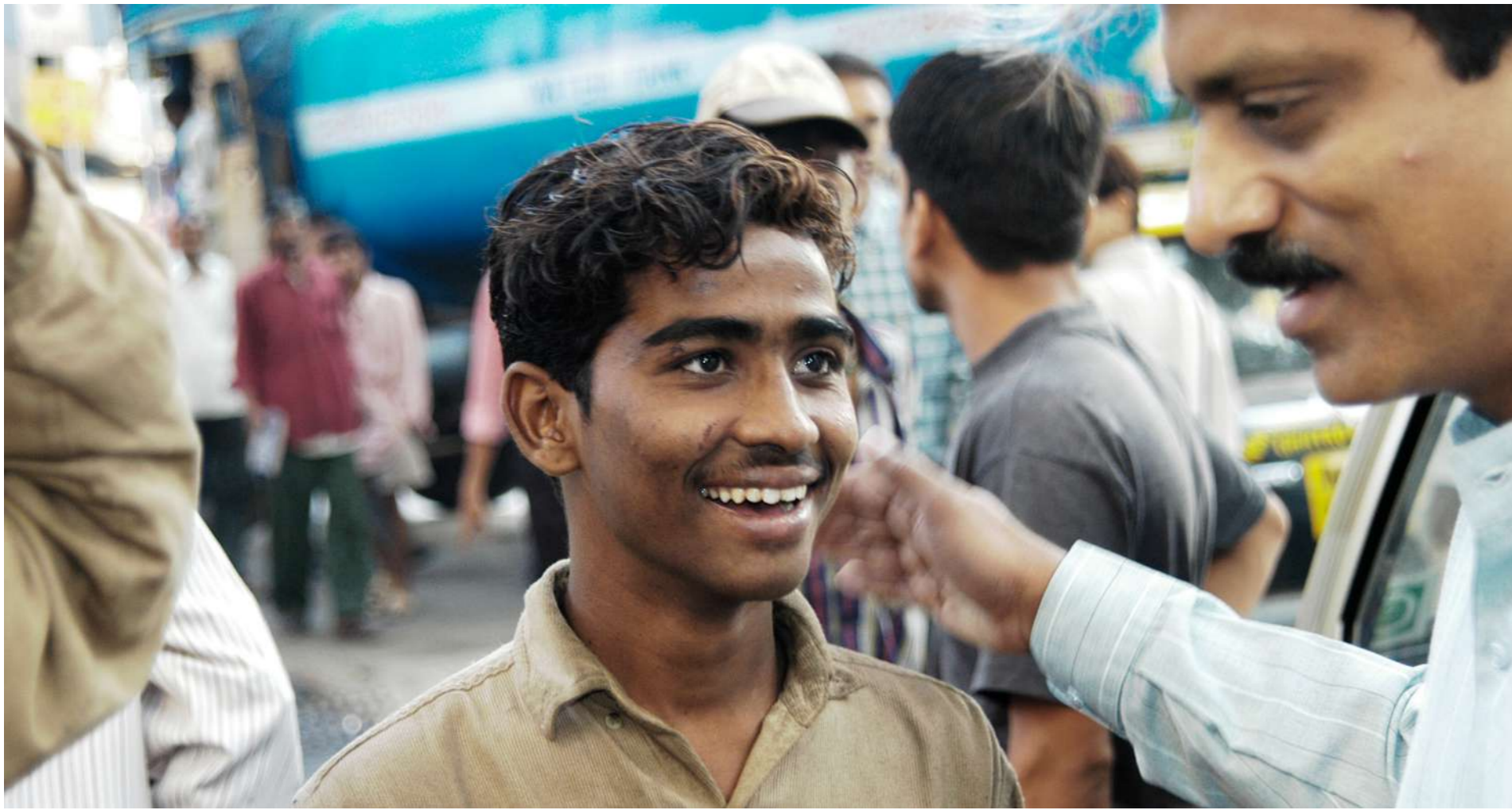
